1. It is compulsory for all students to study Religion and Life, English and a List B subject in Year 12. Students can select these courses at a level which best suits their individual needs.
2. ATAR courses chosen in Year 11 should continue into ATAR Courses in Year 12 unless the student is failing Year 11.
3. Students who wish to gain direct access to University from secondary school are advised to select a minimum of four ATAR courses in Year 12, or speak with Mr Sciorilli for further advice.
4. General Courses do not generally lead to University Entrance subjects in Year 12. Students who wish to pursue TAFE/workforce pathway are encouraged to select these subjects.
5. Students who wish to take ASPIRE/Workplace Learning must submit an online application before they are accepted.
6. Foundation Courses cannot be accessed until a student has failed the Online Literacy and Numeracy Assessment three times.
7. *Engineering Certificate II continues from Year 11 as it is a two-year course.
8. ^Skills for Work Certificate II continues from Year 11 as it is a two-year course.
9. Subject Interviews are not compulsory for students transitioning into Year 12. If students are not achieving a high C grade, or wish to discuss options, they should book a meeting with Mr Sciorilli in Term Three, via Miss Agar.
