YEAR 9 OLNAs TESTING

Writing (Students who achieved Band 8 in Year 7 exempt)	Monday 10 August
Writing Catch-Up	Tuesday 11 August
Numeracy	Thursday 13 August
Reading	Tuesday 25 August
Numeracy and/or Reading Catch Up	Wednesday 26 August

It is the student's responsibility to ensure that his/her computer is fully charged for the testing.
